INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be an Upton resident
- Must be eligible to graduate regardless of high school attending
- Must be planning to attend an accredited college or university
- Must submit your scholarship application by May 1, 2022 to Guidance Department or VFW Post 5594 in Upton, MA

APPLICATION

All applicants will submit a packet containing the following:

- A completed application form
- A personal letter not to exceed 250 words about yourself
- If applicable, a statement describing extenuating financial need and any special family circumstance which might affect your need for the scholarship

REMINDERS FOR APPLICANTS

- 1) Work with your High School counselor to complete your packet
- 2) Do not provide your social security numbers on any documents
- 3) Did you include a statement of financial need if applicable?
- 4) Did your counselor complete and sign the applicable section of the form?
- 5) Did you review and sign your application?
- 6) Applicants who do not answer all questions or provide the requested information will not be considered.
